Father Medaille founded the community in LePuy, France in 1650. He liked to call it the "Con-gregation of the Great Love of God." Mother St. John Fontbonne brought sisters to the United States in 1836, landing near St. Louis, Missouri. Mother Stanislaus founded the community in Concordia, Kansas in 1883. The first Motherhouse was what is now Manna House of Prayer.

Several hundred religious women have followed their calling to a vocation as a Sister of St. Joseph. They remain an apostolic community full of zeal for the charism of unity and reconciliation. The most recent member to make vows was Sister Laurie Kertz.
