THE PROGRAM

We're looking for people sincerely determined to make positive changes for you and your children. Your family may be struggling financially, but you want to become self-sufficient.

Hands Across Our Community is a series of 13 weekly workshops for the participating families and your community coaches.

Expert guest speakers cover such topics as budgeting, goal setting, time management, nutrition, school and work opportunities.

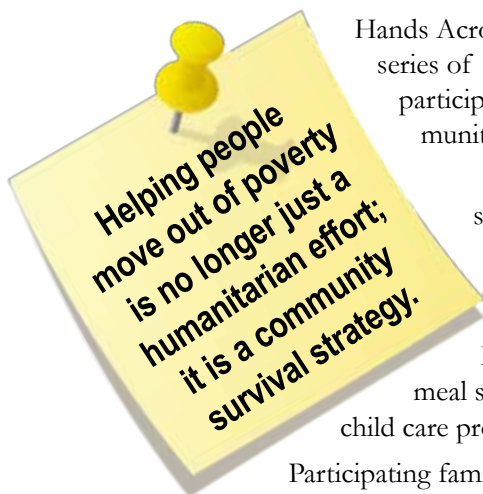
Each workshop includes a meal shared by all present, with child care provided.

Participating families are recruited from throughout the community, and are interviewed before being accepted.

You must make a one-year commitment, pledge to attend at least 11 of the 13 weekly workshops and take an active role in all aspects of the program.

If you meet those requirements, you will receive a small stipend each week.

The program continues with monthly support meetings for at least one year (and longer if appropriate) to strengthen your family's new foundation.
