El Paso, Texas  
June 18—27, 2015

Join us for a one-week experience that delves into the life and culture on the US/Mexico border.

We will see first hand the struggles of the immigrant as we visit shelters, agencies, and cooperatives that serve them.

This experience is sponsored by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Concordia, KS. In our commitment to gospel living and nonviolence, we stand in solidarity with undocumented immigrants. Since this issue is so close to our hearts, the Sisters of St. Joseph are providing a grant to help cover half of the cost.



We will be staying at the Sisters' Grandview Convent in El Paso. Sister Esther Pineda lives there, and will help organize our experience while in El Paso.

Prayer and reflection on Catholic social teachings will be an important part of each of our days.

Space is limited for this experience. We will honor first come, first served in the application process.

We will depart on Thursday, June 18 from Concordia, returning on Saturday, June 27.

The cost to participants is \$250 per person (Sisters of St. Joseph are covering the other \$250 per person). Also, participants will be responsible for purchasing their own food as we travel to and from El Paso.
